

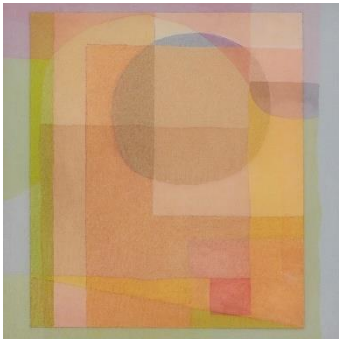

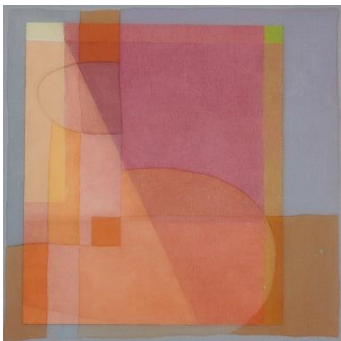
1. As those gold candles fix'd in heaven's air \$3200

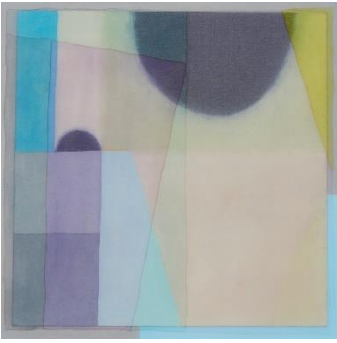

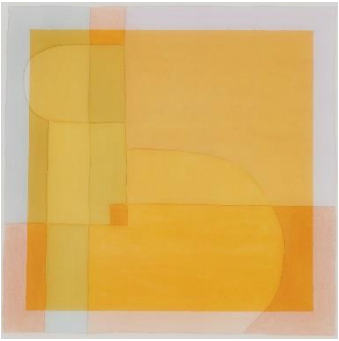
